Nemai Consulting was appointed by Masetlaoka Scott Wilson Consulting Engineers on behalf of the Mpumalanga Department of Culture, Sports and Recreation to undertake the required Environmental Assessment Processes for the proposed HATC in Belfast, Mpumalanga. The proposed development triggers activities listed in Government Notices No. R 544, R545 and R546 and hence requires a full Scoping/EIA study as per the August 2010 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998).

The site is situated on the remaining portion of Farm Belfast Town and Town Lands 357 JT (formerly a portion of Farm Tweefontein 300 JT). The HATC includes the development of four Sports' stadia (Soccer, Cricket, Athletics and Rugby) and Sport's training fields. In addition, a tertiary education Sports Science Academy and Boarding school for Talented Youths will also be developed together with the necessary infrastructure and accommodation. The development is approximately 110 hectares and the land belongs to the Emakhazeni Local Municipality.
